Changes to OSSF Laws – 2010

Laws & playing conditions changes - Under 6 & 7

- Half way re-starts after a goal
- No corner's – goal line re-start regardless of which team touched the ball last. Opposing team back to half way line.
- Indirect free kicks – no penalties
- Children encouraged dribble in or pass from side and goal line re-starts. No need for big kick!

Changes to OSSF Laws – 2010

Laws & playing condition changes - Under 8 – 11

- Minimum & maximum field dimensions – flexibility and may assist for Under 9 and 11 age groups
- Provision for 3m x 2m goals to be used Under 8 & 9 age groups
- Under 11 age group – provision to play box to box in converting a full pitch
- Under 10's no keeping points tables
- Under 11's the recommendation is also not to keep tables
- No offside however, Instructing referee can move players blatantly put in offside positions, Children in the Under 10 & 11 age group should be made aware of offside at training and encouraged to play this way in game situations
